• **Presentation.** Bugs at the bottom of boxes or cobwebs on items are not appealing to people. Display small items on a table and hang up clothing if possible. Putting the price on the top of the item is also suggested. Shoppers can immediately see how much something costs if they are interested. Remember to mow your yard. The better your home looks, the more desirable the merchandise is to buyers.

There may be times when you need a little cash but don't have time to go by the ATM after purchasing groceries at the nearest supermarket. At those times, you can get cash back at participating merchants when you use your MoneyPlus™ Visa Check Card and process it as a 'debit' transaction, rather than a 'credit' transaction.

If you push the debit button, you will be asked to key in your PIN. That is the same PIN you use at ATMs to get cash. Simply key in the four-digit number, and let the cashier know how much extra cash you want. The maximum amount allowed is at the discretion of the merchants.
