simple steps to reduce summer utility bills

We all want to save money. Especially during the summer months when large utility bills can arrive in the mail. Here are a few cost saving tips that will help keep money in your pocket but won't sacrifice your comfort.

Use fans. Overhead fans can keep cool air circulating and lighten the load of the air conditioning unit.

Seal up leaks. Cool air escapes through leaks in windows and doors. If you spot problem areas, seal them with foam or caulking.

Add insulation. If you live in an older home, consider adding insulation to your attic. Some insulation is eligible for federal tax credits.

Regularly inspect your air conditioner. Making sure your system is fully charged and leak-free will ensure it operates as efficiently as possible. Changing air filters can also help.

Close blinds, doors and vents. Closing the blinds when you're not home can keep the sun from heating up rooms. If you won't be using a room, close off the vents and shut the door.
