Members will not be able to purchase tickets at the park on the day of the event. Also, Frontier City season passes will not be accepted for entry to the park that day.

Each individual ticket will cost \$10.00 and will not be refundable. Children ages two or younger will receive free admission

to the park. There is a limit of six (6) tickets per primary member account. Members who purchase six tickets will also receive a parking voucher.

The Wild West Water Works, with over 198 ways to get wet, will be open. The park requires proper swim attire to enjoy this attraction.

- Ages 15 to 18 (as of January 1, 2015)

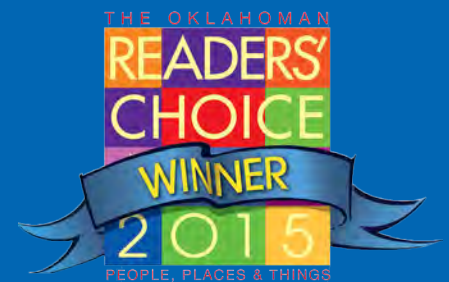
