Thousands of people have fallen victim to this scam over the past couple of years, but you don't have to be one of them.



If there are no nominations by petition, the two candidates nominated by the Nominating and Elections Committee will be elected by acclamation at the Annual Shareholders' Meeting. There will be no nominations from the floor.

The Annual Shareholders' Meeting will be held Saturday, April 2, 2016, at Rose State College Communications Center (Performing Arts Theater) in Midwest City. Things to consider when shopping for a credit card.

What are your spending habits?

Choose a card that works best with your spending habits. If you use the card for day-to-day purchases, shop for a card with a generous limit and a good rewards program. If you carry a balance, focus on getting a good rate.

How high is the interest rate?

Your interest rate, also known as APR or annual percentage rate, will largely depend on your credit rating. The lower the APR, the better, especially if you carry a balance.

Balance transfer fee.

If you are looking to transfer your credit balance to another card, find one that does not charge a transfer fee, such as our Visa Platinum card.

Late payment charges.

Look for a card offering the lowest penalty fees. Late payment or overthe-limit fees, if incurred, can stack up quickly, and make it more difficult to pay off the balance.

Cash advance fees.

These charges typically range from 2%-4% with some credit cards. If you find yourself making cash advances often, find a card with the lowest possible fee. Our Visa Platinum card has zero cash advance fees.

Find rewards that match your spending habits.

Look for a rewards program that offers you rewards you'll actually use. However, don't let rewards tempt you into carrying a high balance. Interest charges can easily offset rewards.
