
More Give Back winners this year.

Introductory rate is applicable for 12 months from the day of loan closing. After the 12-month introductory rate period, the rate will convert to a variable rate. The maximum APR that can apply is 18.00% or the maximum permitted by law, whichever is less. The APR is subject to change monthly and will vary based on each member's credit history, term and ITV. Member must carry insurance on the property talt secures an equity loan. If the property is located in a Special Flood Hazard Area, we will require the member to obtain flood insurance if it is available. Normal underwriting guidelines apply. **Rate range of 3.45% APR – 7.95% APR is effective as of March 2016, and is subject to change monthly. Closing Costs vary according to property location, but typically range between \$423 and \$670. Title Insurance is required on loan requests of \$100,000 or more. The cost of the Title Insurance policy is based on your loan amount; the typical range is \$365 – \$3800. In addition, you will be required to pay the fees for abstracting and other related title work, whether or not TFCU funds the loan. These fees normally range from \$550 or \$725.
