All you need to do to set a

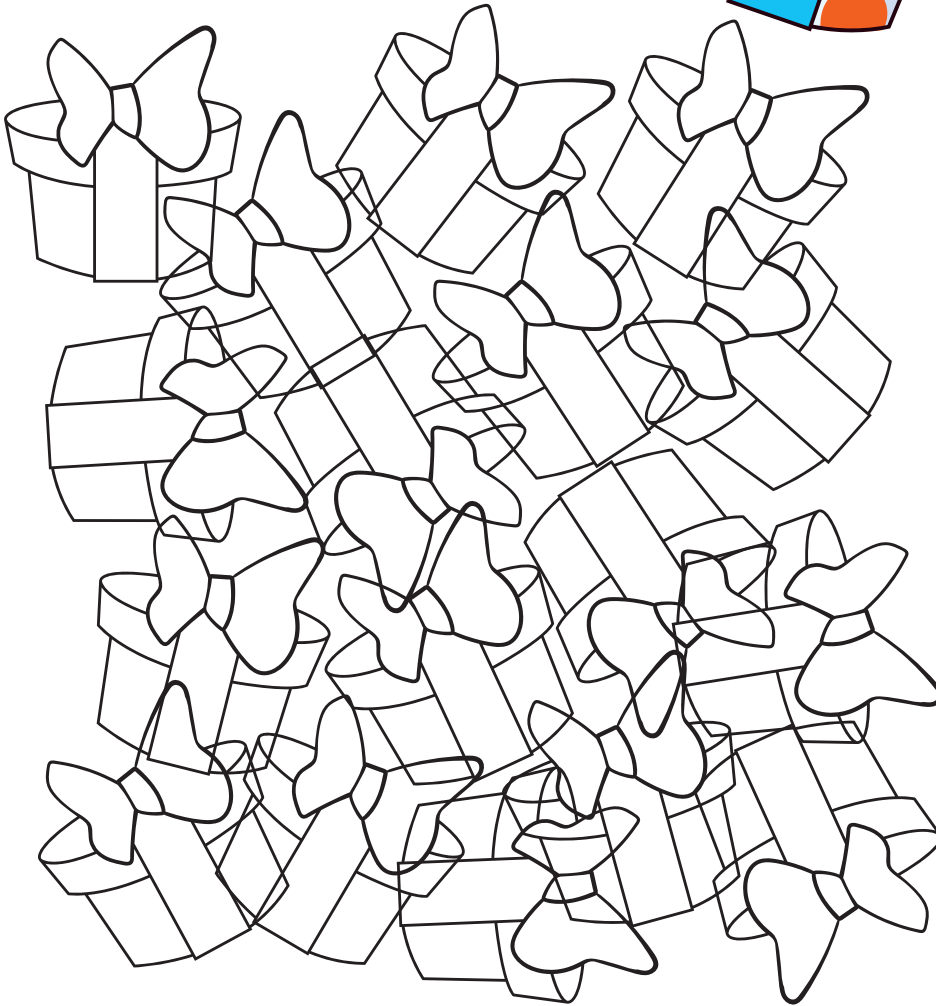
savings goal is know what it is you want to buy, how much you need to save to make the purchase, when you want to have it and a plan in place to save up money for it.

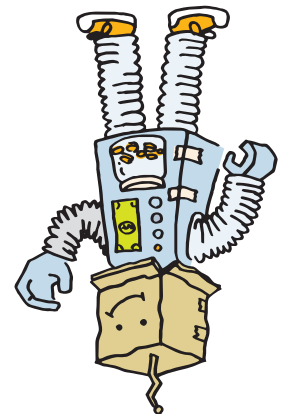
